Traditional Chinese Painting Experience Workshop

Activity goal

- Understand the basic characteristics of traditional Chinese painting.
- Learn fundamental techniques of Chinese painting, including brushwork (center stroke and side stroke), ink application (variations in intensity, dryness, and wetness), composition, and basic use of negative space.
- Cultivate an appreciation for and interest in traditional Chinese art

Activity summary

Invite a professional Chinese painting master to conduct an experiential ink painting activity for young children, introducing the traditional tools of Chinese painting—brush, ink, paper, and inkstone. Through simple and engaging ink-based activities, children will collaboratively create artworks centered on themes such as “animals” and “family affection.” In alignment with Po Leung Kuk’s “Kindergarten–Primary Alliance” initiative, selected works will be exhibited at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre and opened to the public. This not only affirms the children’s creative achievements but also conveys the beauty of traditional Chinese culture to the wider community.
