Activity name

Understand and Recognize the Hundred Family Surnames

Activity goal

- Learn and recognize common Chinese surnames
- Create simple art pieces themed around their own surnames, training fine motor skills in the process
- Promote children's self-identity and respect for others, while helping them understand the "Hundred Family Surnames" as a symbol of the unity and harmony of China's diverse ethnic groups

Activity summary

Taking the classic Chinese text *Hundred Family Surnames* as the starting point, parents and children will explore the origins and meanings of their family surnames. Students will then use a variety of materials — including colored paper, beans, pipe cleaners, colored sand, and tape — to create their own surnames through hands-on collage work. These creations will be displayed throughout the school, allowing everyone to feel the richness and depth of Chinese surname culture as well as the warm power of family tradition and heritage.
