

### **Activity name**

Blue and white porcelain

## **Activity aim**

- Be able to appreciate works about Chinese culture
- Be able to learn the skills of painting blue and white porcelain
- Be able to develop interest in Chinese culture

## **Activity summary**

At the beginning of the activity, teacher introduced the history and characteristics of blue and white porcelain to children, and let them understand that blue and white porcelain is a traditional ceramic originating from China and is famous for its unique style of blue patterns on a white background.
