Activity name

"Happiness Dyed Handkerchief"

Activity goal

- Young children can appreciate works about Chinese culture.
- Young children can master tie-dying techniques.
- Young children can develop interest in Chinese culture.

Activity summary

Before the activity begins, children are invited to appreciate works about Chinese culture to build their preliminary understanding of Chinese culture. During the activity, under the guidance of the teacher, children tried to imitate the teacher in folding and dyeing hand towels, thereby creating unique hand-dyed hand towels. During the activity, children can give full play to their creativity, design their favorite patterns and color combinations, and experience their own ideas. In addition, tie-dyed hand towels require the use of hands for dyeing, which can improve children's hand coordination and finger dexterity. At the same time, by learning about Chinese tie-dyed hand towels, children can develop their understanding and interest in Chinese culture. We believe that this activity will bring enjoyable experiences and valuable learning opportunities to young children.

Activity name

Come and experience Chinese art

Activity goal

- Can name different Chinese arts
- Able to design handicrafts with different techniques
- Able to appreciate Chinese art

Activity summary

The teacher will first introduce Chinese art (Chinese facial makeup, blue and white porcelain) to the children, and then ask the children to try and observe the special features. After observation and the teacher's explanation, the teacher will ask the children to try to design these two handicrafts.

After completion, the teacher will introduce the famous plum blossoms in China to the children, and at the same time let the children make plum blossoms by blowing water. Finally, the teacher will use the children' s artwork as a poster design.

Activity name

"Creative Ink Painting"

Activity goal

- Young children can draw different scenery.
- Children can master the strength of the brush and the control of ink when using the brush .
- Young children can increase their interest in traditional Chinese culture .

Activity summary

By showing pictures of ink paintings, the teacher guides the children to observe and appreciate the scenery in the pictures , guiding the children to perceive the characteristics of ink paintings and get in touch with traditional Chinese culture . Before starting, let the children learn the brushstrokes and the use of pigments in ink painting , so that they can understand that ink painting requires special pigments and that there will be changes in shades after adding water . After the teacher demonstrates how to use a brush , the teacher then asks the children to draw mountains, lakes, flowers, etc. to form a landscape painting with Chinese characteristics . While the children are creating , the teacher allows the children to draw independently and provides individual guidance according to the children's performance. After completion, the teacher creates an opportunity for the children to display and appreciate the works , focusing on understanding the children's inner feelings and expressions, encouraging the children from the perspective of affirmation and appreciation, and improving the children 's concentration through the technique of controlling the ink painting slowly and not hastily. Strength and creativity , while experiencing the fun of traditional Chinese art .
