Activity name: K1 and K2 - Playscope

Activity Aims: By participating in games and activities in Playscope, children can experience the fun of games from multiple angles, so that children are able to learn from games by facing different challenges.

(1) Activity content:

 Free play independently and materials: Children are allowed to play freely in the four-thousand feet indoor play space with using any materials they are interested in.
Theme Room – Farm: By equipping with farm-related materials such as straw hats and straw, it provides a real farming experience, including growing food and irrigation.
Messy World: Space is provided for children to draw or paint on the wall in order to show their creation.

4. Rope Net and Play box: Aerial rope nets and tunnels are used to promote physical exercise and exploration.

(2) Activity result:

Knowledge and skills: The farm theme room provides practical farming experience, that helps children in learning natural science knowledge and increasing the awareness of ecological environment. Artistic activities and physical play promote the development of creativity, fine motor skills and physical coordination.

Values and attitudes: Free play and materials encourage independent thinking and decision-making skills of children. They have to clean up by themselves at the end of activity, which can cultivate their self-confidence and responsibility.

Learning interest: Diverse games and activities are able to stimulate curiosity and desire of children to explore, and enhance their learning motivation. Educating and entertaining through games are able to enhance the learning interest of children. Achieve activity aims: Activity allows children to experience the fun of games from multiple angles by providing a diverse selection of games and activities. At the same time, the challenges and difficulties contained in these activities can encourage children to learn how to accept and overcome challenges through games in order to

achieve self-growth and development.

Suggestions:

1. Increasing on-site staff: Make sure there are enough staff to provide supervision and guidance in all activity areas, especially those spaces present safety risks such as rope net and ramps with sharp edges. This helps resolving safety issues in time with providing necessary help and guidance.

2. Material replenishment station: A material replenishment station can be set in the Messy World to ensure that paints and other art supplies can be replenished in time. In this way, children will not be restricted due to shortage of supplies when creating.

In activity scene of Rope Net, children bring materials to the rope net to play games, including a snake doll and orange balloons. Happiness and positive emotions of children can be seen by their interaction. There are different roles among them in holding the head and tail of the snake doll separately, and work together to move the doll on the rope net.
