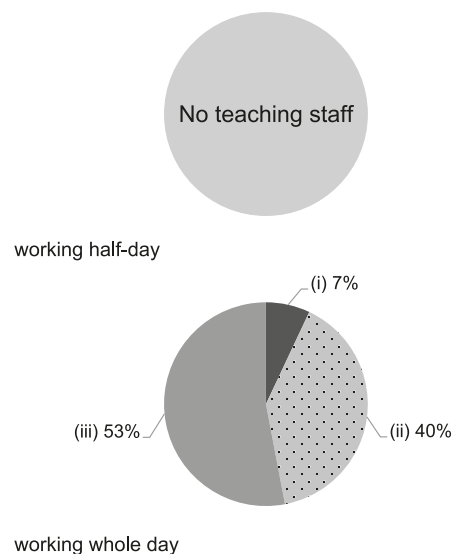
Curriculum Details

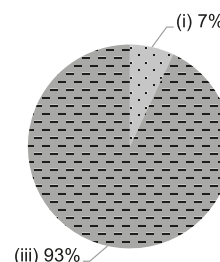
