

23rd August, 2021Notice on Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach (Free of Charge)

Dear Parents,

In order to cooperate with the '2021/22 Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach (Free of Charge)' of the Centre for Health Protection of Hong Kong to prevent influenza from breaking out on campus 'School Influenza Vaccination' is now arranged for free injections for students in our school.

Recommendations from CHP of Hong Kong:

- Vaccination is a safe and effective way to prevent seasonal influenza and related complications.
- The 'Science Committee on Vaccine Preventable Diseases' recommends children age of 6 months to 11 years old as one of the priority groups. Vaccinating young school children can reduce school absenteeism and influenza transmission in the community.
- Children under the age of 9 who are vaccinated for the first time with influenza vaccine, they have to receive 2 doses (at least 4 weeks apart)

Date:	1 st dose 22 nd October, 2021(Friday) / 2 nd dose 10 th December, 2021(Friday)
Time:	11:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. (During this period)
Name of the vaccination:	Seasonal influenza vaccination (Injection)
Service Provider:	Po Leung Kuk Making Life Beautiful Integrated Health Center
Fee	Free of Charge (Eligible children who is 6 months to under 12 years old was supported by the government)
Modus	Administered by registered doctors and nurses (Must be accompanied by parents)
All students who join, please return the following documents on 10th September, 2021 :	
1. Sign the 'Consent Form – Injectable Vaccine form CHP of Hong Kong which will distributed in early September, 2021.	
2. Seasonal influenza Vaccination Card (if any)	
3. Copy of ID/Birth Certification	
Remarks:	
1. If the student do not get the 1 st dose vaccination, the 1 st dose will be given on 10/12/2021.	
2. If the student do not get the 2 nd dose because of illness or absence, please bring a copy of ID , Notification on Vaccination, Vaccination Voucher to Po Leung Kuk Making Life Beautiful Integrated Health Center, and receive the vaccination for free one week after recovery.	
3. Some may experience fever, muscle pain and tiredness 6 to 12 hours after vaccination and lasting up to 2 days. If fever or discomforts persist, please consult a doctor. Immediate severe allergic reactions like hives, swelling of the lips or tongue and difficulties in breathing are rare, please require emergency consultation.
