Flag Raising Ceremony

Objective(s)

- Understand the national flag and the etiquette of raising the national flag
- Understand the flag raising ceremony and learn to demonstrate a solemn and respectful attitude when the national anthem is played
- Develop a preliminary understanding of the national flag, national anthem and national emblem, and cultivate a sense of national identity from a young age

Brief Descriptions:

Schools conduct flag-raising ceremonies during the morning/afternoon assembly on the first school day of the week, allowing young children to learn the etiquette and relevant knowledge and attitudes of the flag-raising ceremony, and foster a sense of national identity. Flag-raising ceremonies are also held when celebrating New Year's Day, the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, and National Day, so that young children can establish a good sense of citizenship.

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Chinese Mid-Autumn Festival Celebration

Objective(s)

- Understand the food and celebratory activities of the Mid-Autumn Festival
- Enhance children's understanding of Chinese traditional festival culture
- Experience the atmosphere of the festival

Brief Descriptions:

Through activities such as Mid-Autumn Festival stories, making small lanterns, and introducing traditional festival foods, children can learn about the origin and traditional customs of the Mid-Autumn Festival, experience the festival atmosphere together, and further understand the traditional culture of Chinese festivals.

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Parent-Child Lunar New Year Celebration cum Chinese Culture Day

Objective(s)

- Understand the food and traditional customs of the Lunar New Year
- Experience the art and joy of traditional Chinese folk games through hands-on activities
- Cultivate children's strong interest in Chinese culture

Brief Descriptions:

Chinese New Year is one of the traditional Chinese festivals. Our school hosted parent-child booth games where children dressed in traditional Chinese attire to experience the festive atmosphere of the Lunar New Year alongside their parents. In addition to mini-games like the lion dance and "picking the greens", activities included making dragon beard candy/scallion pancakes, as well as booth game experiences such as rubbings of Spring Festival couplets, pitch-pot, and Chinese golf. These allowed children to learn about and enjoy the fun and wisdom of traditional Chinese folk arts through hands-on participation.

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Parent-Child Chinese Cultural Storybook Reading & Air-Dry Clay Workshops

Objective(s)

- Encourage parents and children to read books on Chinese culture together, guiding children to practice traditional virtues in daily life
- To introduce elements of traditional Chinese culture, nurturing children's appreciation and passion for Chinese arts and heritage
- Enhance hand-eye coordination, creativity, and imagination while fostering interactive bonding and communication between parents and children

Brief Descriptions:

This event invited parents and children to spark their creativity within a rich cultural setting through the Chinese Cultural Storytelling Workshop. As ceramic art represents a significant pillar of Chinese culture, the Parent-Child Air-Dry Clay Workshop was held to deepen students' understanding of traditional Chinese arts. Through joint clay creations, families experienced the charm and fun of traditional craftsmanship first-hand, strengthening parent-child relationships while preserving and passing on traditional Chinese culture.

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Tuen Ng Festival Activities

Objective(s)

- Recognize Dragon Boat Festival foods and celebratory activities
- Enhance children's strong interest in Chinese culture
- Experience the festive atmosphere

Brief Descriptions:

The Dragon Boat Festival is a traditional festival commemorating Qu Yuan. The school organized a dragon boat racing activity, allowing students to experience the joy of dragon boat racing, make zongzi (rice dumplings), and listen to stories. Through this, children can learn about the history and customs of the Dragon Boat Festival, and foster interest and respect for Chinese culture.

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Chinese Cultural Experience Activities

Objective(s)

- Learn about traditional Chinese delicacies through hands-on pan-fried rice cakes and osmanthus jelly making
- Appreciate artistic beauty through paper-cutting and tie-dye crafts
- Discover the art and charm of Beijing Opera

Brief Descriptions:

Our school incorporates elements of Chinese culture across various learning themes, ensuring that our profound traditional heritage is continuously passed down. In teaching units centered on Chinese culture, hands-on learning experiences—including pan-frying New Year rice cakes (Nian Gao), making osmanthus jelly, paper-cutting, crafting New Year ornaments, learning tie-dye techniques, and appreciating Beijing Opera—are seamlessly connected to children's everyday experiences. This approach empowers students to continuously explore and develop a deep appreciation for diverse Chinese traditional customs.
