- Our school will arrange Zoom lessons until 10 March, 2022 (Thursday).
- Teacher Development Day is on 11 March, 2022 (Friday), there will be no zoom class.
- The Special Vacation will start from 14 March,2022 (Monday) until the end of the school Easter holidays. The last school day in the current school year is 5 August,2022 (Friday).
- The school Easter Holidays will end on 22 April,2022 (Friday), children will resume to school on 25April,2022 (Monday). The announcement about the class resumption arrangements will also be made by Education Bureau later. Please pay attention on SPC read the school circular.

- To consolidate children's learning, the school will upload holiday worksheet on every Monday during Special Vacation Period. Please feel free to download the worksheets for children to finish and submit them after the holiday.
- To cultivate children's reading habit, parents are recommended to log in to the "Cambridge English Channel" and read e-books with children.

In the Special Vacation Period, Epidemic prevention measures are taken to ensure the campus environment is clean and hygienic. In view of the severity of the epidemic, the EDB strongly appealed to parents and students to avoid going out, having crowd gatherings and social contacts as well as dining out.
