

Po Leung Kuk Tin Ka Ping Kindergarten 2021/2022 K1-K3 Admission Schedule

- Children who were born on or before 31st December, 2018 and will be attending K1 classes.
- Children who were born on or before 31st December, 2017 and will be attending K2 classes.
- Children who were born on or before 31st December, 2016 and will be attending K3 classes.

**** Children must be Hong Kong residents with right of abode, right to land or valid permission to remain without any condition of stay (other than the limit of stay) in Hong Kong.**

From September to November 2020	<p><u>Apply “2021/2022 Registration Certificate”</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Apply to the Education Bureau for the “2021/2022 Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” or the “Kindergarten Admission Pass” ➤ The Government will implement the “Free Quality Kindergarten Education Scheme” (hereafter referred to as “Scheme”) starting from the 2017/18 school year. Each child who can receive education in Hong Kong will only be issued a registration document and all Scheme-KGs can only admit students holding a valid registration document. ➤ Parents are required to submit an application for the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” (hereafter referred as “RC”) to EDB from September to November 2020. The “RC” will be open for applications in September 2020 and EDB will announce and upload the details of application onto EDB’s website (http://www.edb.gov.hk/) in due course. Upon receipt of the applications with all necessary information and documents provided, EDB will generally take six to eight weeks to complete processing of the applications and issue the “RC” to applicants who are eligible for receiving subsidy under the Scheme by post. If a student cannot obtain an “RC” as he/she can receive education in Hong Kong but is not eligible for receiving subsidy under the Scheme, EDB will then issue a “Kindergarten Admission Pass” (hereafter referred to as “AP”) to the student concerned for registration and admission to a Scheme-KG but the parents concerned are required to pay full school fees before deduction of subsidy under the Scheme as shown on the Fees Certificate of the KG to which the child is admitted. <p>#Note 1: All non-local students who enter Hong Kong for the purpose of education in Hong Kong (for example, holders of student visas) must obtain prior permission from the Director of Immigration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ The details of admission arrangements for nursery (K1) classes in kindergartens onto EDB’s website: www.edb.gov.hk/k1-admission_e
